Staunton State Park offers a natural setting with a wide variety of climbing opportunities ranging from hard sport climbs to easy traditional climbs. Climbing routes range from 1 to 3 pitches in length and generally vary by area. Staunton State Park opened to the public in 2013 and route development is ongoing.

Additional climbing route information can be obtained from Fixed Pin Publishing, Mountain Project, or Rakkup.

Gear and climbing varies widely throughout the park and not all traditional routes have anchors, please refer to the guidebooks before racking up.

Climbing Guidelines:

Fixed hardware cannot be placed or removed without a permit. Details are at sspfhrg.com. Sspfhrg is a group of local volunteer climbers.

Seasonal raptor closures may be in effect for some climbing areas, Feb. 1 thru Aug. 1. Check with Park or Mountain Project for status.

Pets must be leashed and under control at all times, everywhere in the park.

Use care to stay on trails. If you must go off trail, choose the

most durable surfaces.

Pack out all trash. Clean up after yourself and others. Use the toilet facilities provided whenever possible.

Commercial Use (i.e. guiding, filming, photography, drone use, etc.) requires a permit.

The Park closes at 10pm year-round.
